



ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

State law requires recycling of the following electronics:

Televisions, monitors, printers, computers, electronic keyboards, facsimile machines, videocassette recorders, portable digital music players, digital video disc players, video game consoles, small scale servers, scanners, electronic mice, digital converter boxes, cable receivers, satellite receivers and digital video disc recorders.

(Illinois Electronics Products Recycling and Reuse Act)

The items above **WILL NOT BE PICKED UP** curbside or with our bulky waste collection.

The City of LeRoy **WILL NOT** host an electronics recycling program any time soon, due to the exorbitant cost.

Electronics **MAY NOT** be set out to the curb or dumped on other's people's property or in the trash receptacles. **CITATIONS WILL BE ISSUED.**

Self-Service Electronic Recycling Hours at Normal Recycling Site:

There may not be anyone to help you unload your electronics so we recommend you bring someone to help if you have electronics that are too heavy for you to handle.

Summer Hours (Memorial Day - Labor Day)

The following items are also accepted:

- Most forms of electronic media and their cases (diskettes, zip disks, CDs, CD-Rs, CDRWs, DVDs, game cartridges, DAT, DLT, Beta or Digi beta and virtually all other type of computer tapes)- **not audio or video tapes**
- All forms of printer cartridges, including both inkjet and toner
- All types of cell phones, pagers, PDAs and their chargers, cables and headset accessories. Please note that cell phones and chargers can be dropped off at the Police department for re-use by victims of domestic violence.
- All small computer accessories, such as MP3 players, iPods, digital cameras, hand-held scanners, hand-held games and other connected devices

Non-Accepted Items at Normal Recycling Site:

- Large appliances □ Items containing Freon (air conditioners, □ Light bulbs
dehumidifiers, mini refrigerators)
- Items containing liquids □ Audio Tapes
- Batteries (AA, AAA, D, C & lithium) □ Medical Equipment
- VHS Cassette Tapes □ Gas Cylinders
