Memorial Day domestic dispute results in two felony arrests:

Police were called to Loves truck stop around 6:30 AM. Investigation revealed that as a result of a domestic argument that Matthew K. Dotson, 33, Pekin, had rammed a vehicle occupied by David B. Nail, 44, Pekin with his vehicle and fled the scene. LeRoy Officers broadcast an attempt to locate, and Dotson was stopped by Pekin Police and detained for LeRoy PD.

Nail was arrested by for Aggravated Unlawful Use of Weapons for having a loaded handgun under the seat without a FOID or Concealed Carry permit, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Possession of 1.9 grams of Crystal Methamphetamine. He remains lodged in the McLean County jail pending a bond hearing on the felony charges.

Dotson was arrested in Pekin by LeRoy PD for Felony Criminal Damage to Property, Domestic Battery, and Possession of a Controlled Substance. He remains lodged in the McLean County jail pending a bond hearing on the felony charges.

Arrests are based on probable cause and all arrestees are presumed innocent until proven guilty in court. Formal charges by the McLean County State's Attorney are expected on Tuesday, May 29.
