Records Request, Illinois Criminal Identification Act

Public Act 99-697 amended the Cannabis Control Act, 720 ILCS 550/1, *et seq.* and the Drug Paraphernalia Control Act, 720 ILCS 600/1, *et seq.* to allow the Possession of less than 10 grams of Cannabis and the Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when accompanied by less than 10 grams of Cannabis to be treated as civil violations.

After July 29, 2016, anyone charged by local ordinance for the Possession of less than 10 grams of Cannabis and/or Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia when accompanied by less than 10 grams of Cannabis who has satisfactorily paid the fines related to these offenses is entitled to the expungement of the records related to that offense.

You have the right to request a review of your records to ensure that these records have been expunged in accordance with the requirement of the Illinois Criminal Identification Act. Please submit the following form for that review.
